

Walters composed of one parent/child team from each table should report to the Dining Hall 15 minutes prior to meal time to set the table. Once the meal begins, the waiter team goes to the kitchen for hot food and refills. Waiters should be the only ones up from the table during meals. (Except for restroom breaks)

Trail Rides are offered at specific times during the weekend, but should be signed up for at check-in to ensure efficiency at the Main Barn. The Wranglers will determine the appropriate horse for each rider as well as the appropriate type of ride for each participant. Camp Tippecanoe has made it a policy not to allow anyone under 7 years of age or under 48" in height to go out on the trail. These individuals will be given the opportunity to ride a horse in the riding ring under the supervision of our staff. Parents of these individuals may either take the trail ride or ride in the ring along with their child.

Pontoon Boat Rides are offered at specific times throughout the weekend, but should be signed up for at check-in to ensure efficiency at the Waterfront.

Life Jackets are required to be worn at all times when in the boats.
